Last year, we focused on diabetes and it's complications. Children were educated about the bad effects of consuming junk foods. With the help of philanthropists, we reached out to help the victims of floods in Kerala state. Students from various colleges in India did their internships at Sahara, as a part of their completion of studies, successfully by studying the diversified activities of Sahara done in the welfare of the poorest of the poor section of the society. They also interacted with the beneficiaries. I thank all our patrons, members, staff, volunteers and well wishers for their continued support and cooperation. I also thank the media for the coverage of Sahara's activities from time to time, as a part of dissemination of information to the general public.

CHILDREN & EDUCATION

CHILD SPONSORSHIP:

With a priority to help girl child, 78 Girls and 35 boys belonging to vulnerable families, mostly semi/orphan children and children from poor families enlisted with Sahara. Among them 46 Girls and 14 boys were supported. Depending upon the donations received, these children are being supported according to their needs and availability of support. They were provided with supplies of nutrition, toiletries, educational material, dresses, tuition fee, health care and emergency needs.

SPONSOR FOR HIGHER EDUCATION:

Among the enlisted, more than 15 students have completed schooling and gone for higher education including intermediate, graduation and post graduation

SPONSOREES - SPONSORING:

Those who got support earlier for education and got a job are now donating to Sahara to help other students. It's a welcome approach - *Take & Give*.

SANITARY NAPKINS:

As a part of creating awareness among young girls on Hygiene and healthy practices, Sanitary napkins were distributed to 25 girls from weaker section families with the help of donors



Dhanalaxmi is studying 9th class in a private School at Amberpet, Hyderabad. She has one elder brother going to school. Her father committed suicide due to financial crisis. The family migrated from Karimnagar district for livelihood in the year 2005. Her mother is taking care of her two children by working as a maid servant, living in a small rented room. She has no other income source or support from any one. The income that she gets is very meager and not sufficient to meet all the need of the children. Sahara with the help of donors is helping her to some extent.

HELP THE AGED

Adopt a destitute Aged:

The elderly who are living in the community without any care and support were identified and adopted by Sahara. They are provided with monthly sustenance support such as nutrition and toiletry items, health care, clothes and other needed support time to time. This program ensures support for their life time. In the beginning of the year there were 40 elders and 5 aged died during the year. Another 20 are on occasional support and seeking regular adoption.

Awareness on Age Care:

There is a need to create Awareness on the increasing problems of Aged and the need to provide care and support to them. This message was imparted to the younger generation in the society. As a part of it, conducted campaigns to create awareness and to help the aged was initiated among the students of different schools. The message of extending love and concern by one and all was spread by more than1500 students and teachers of 5different schools.

Students, Teachers and Managements contributing for Aged:

The students and teachers of BVB High School in Amberpet felt the need to help the poor and needy aged and contributed in kind. The students of St. Joseph School conducting a fund raising campaign to help the aged. Sri Aurobindo International school management contributing regularly to Sahara to help the aged





Mongari Anasuyamma, aged about 72 years stays with her younger daughter in a slum of Hyderabad. Her four sons died at a young age and she is having two daughters at present. After death of her husband she started living with her younger daughter whose husband used work as daily wage labor, who used take care of his children and as well Anasuyamma. Unfortunately, he died with heart attack. Earlier she used work in a house as a maid servant, now she is not in a position to do any work due to health problems. Her daughters are not in a position to take care of her. SAHARA is providing monthly sustenance support.

World Elders Day was organized by SAHARA at its centre in Amberpet, Hyderabad on Saturday, 29th Sept, 2018. On this occasion, games and entertainment programs were conducted for the 45 adopted and other elderly living in different slums. Awards and gifts were presented to the winners. Pocket money, refreshments, lunch, nutrition and toiletry items were provided to them. The elderly felt so happy for organizing a day for them though they don't have any one of their own.



HEALTH CARE

CHILDREN & AGED:

Quarterly Health camps were organized at Sahara covering different slum areas of Amberpet, Hyderabad for the children, women and aged. More than 120 patients were covered regularly during the year. Apart from health checkup, the mothers were educated on seasonal diseases that come in and the food habits of children that affect the health of the children. Identified chronic cases were referred to different hospitals for treatment

DIABETIC RETINOPATHY:

In association with Dr Radhika of IIPH, Diabetic Retinopathy awareness camps were organized in different localities of Amberpet Constitution. The elders, including the family members were made aware of consequences of diabetic impact on eye sight and loosing the sight due to diabetes. Awareness was created thro video shows and pamphlets and the need to go for regular eye checkup. A free check up facility was created at SPARK eye care facility. More than 600 elders were covered under the program.

YOGA - MEDITATION:

Yoga and meditation was introduced for children, women and elderly beneficiaries of Sahara. Special classes were organized to impart yoga and meditation for children and aged for their health and well being. After initiating the classes asked them to practice at their home.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT- SKILL UP GRADATION

WOMEN'S DAY:

Women's day was organized on 9th March 2019 at Sahara Training Centre calling under privileged women for empowering. On the occasion, the invitee guests enlightened the women on self-reliance and their role in family development. Various competitions were conducted to encourage women and awards were presented. The women who completed in various training courses were awarded with certificates. More than 35 women attended the celebrations.

BEAUTICIAN TRAINING:

Beautician Skills were imparted among young women and adolescents. Training was provided to 15 young women and school dropout girls from poor and middle class families in Amberpet, Hyderabad. After the successful training, the candidates were referred for placements with beauty parlors and they got successful employability potential.



VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN TAILORING & FASHION DESIGN:



With the support of Rotary Club of Hyderabad three months Tailoring-Fashion design course was run benefitting 23 young women and adolescent girls in the slum areas of Amberpet. Certificates were awarded to them by the Rotarian Governor along with their president and members on 2nd May 2018. A regular training centre is being run by Sahara at its head office in Amberpet and trained additional 25 candidates during the year. More than 90% of the trainees could earn and support their families after the training.

COMPUTER, WORKPLACE ENGLISH & LIFE SKILLS :

To create employability potential among youth and young women, regular training programs were conducted in computer basics with workplace English and life skills. After the training, they were provided free placement and referral services to different areas. 45 candidates belonging to weaker sections, school and college drop outs got trained under this program

OFFICE ASSISTANT TRAINING:

A fully fledged training with practical knowledge was given to 18 candidates who discontinued their education at different level, so that they can get equipped with the office management knowledge and get employment opportunities. These candidates were placed in different firms after the training and we have also encouraged them to complete their studies while working.



SUPPORT FOR INCOME GENERATION:

Initiated the activities to support the women for income generation in the form of pretty trade, sewing machine were provided to work at home at their convenient time, start a beauty culture centre, run tuition centre or other viable activities so that they can earn and add income to support the family. 8 families got support under this program.





ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

Say No To Plastic:

Awareness Campaigns were organized in 3 schools creating awareness among students, teachers and parents on the plastic covers usage and its consequences. At the same time supplied cotton bags to replace the plastic covers.

Awareness on E waste Management:

The schools participated on E waste Management include St. Joseph High School, Bharathi Vidya Bhavan High School, St Amber School (Amberpet), Nalanda School (LB Nagar), Govt. High School (LB Nagar), Govt High School (NTR Nagar) during the month of July 2018. Ms Alekhya from Lovely Professional University, Punjab has taken active part in organizing the events as part of her Community Development project work

Collection of E-waste:

Mobilized E-waste collection drive, the collected e-waste was sent for recycling. Advised public not to through ewaste in the regular waste bins and also not to sell it to vendors under waste material as it may pollute the environment if it is dumped without segregation. Recycle collection point was set up at our office to facilitate the collection of e waste.



Rain water units maintenance:

Yearly maintenance of 5-Rain water Recharge and Recycling units which were constructed earlier in different villages of Mahabubnagar, Karimnagar, Nizamabad and Medak districts of Telangana were monitored. These units are maintained with the support of beneficiaries, villagers school authorities including students by further creating awareness on saving rain water for future

Grow more trees follow-up :

From the beginning of Sahara, it has been planting sapling and taking care of its growth. In the recent time, since State Government is planting the saplings in a massive scale, Sahara is monitoring its planted saplings until it grows and takes care of itself. The responsibility of the caring is handed over to the students, youth, SHG members and Elderly. Regular monitoring was done in 5 villages to encourage survival of the plants including those planted in the previous years.



KERALA FLOOD RELIEF ACTIVITIES



SAHARA has provided assistance to Kerala flood victims. Relief activities were undertaken by our Senior Staff Ms Sajitha, along with local volunteers and SHG members in the villages of Perunad, Kottukapara, Madathummuzhi, Nedumon and the areas on the bank of Kakkat river under Maniyar irrigation project of Pathanamthitta district. Apart from distribution of immediate essential needs, support has been provided for

reconstruction of 22 houses which were fully merged under water in Nedumon village of Perunad Panchayat. The services and the support include reaching out to the unreached areas by other teams. Our Relief Team cleaned the houses and approach roads, supplied clean drinking water, food grains, nutrition and toiletry items, dresses and clothes. Our special thanks to our donors P. 
